**ORDER TO FILE TIMELY AND ACCURATE
QUARTERLY AND ANNUAL REPORTS**

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order to File Timely and Accurate Quarterly and Annual Reports against RYDACO, LLC (“RYDACO”).¹

Statement of Facts and Law

RYDACO is a credit services organization licensed to act as a credit access business under Chapter 393 of the Texas Finance Code. RYDACO operates under master file number 1600055034 at multiple licensed location, under license numbers 156493, 156494, 156495, 156496, 156497, 156499, 156502, 156504, 156506, and 156507. RYDACO’s compliance officer is Kara Fleming, and its designated contact address is 709 Southview Circle Center, Texas 75935.

A credit access business must file quarterly and annual reports with the OCCC for all licensed locations.² All information on the reports must be accurate and calculated in accordance with the OCCC’s instructions.³ The reports are due by the following deadlines each year:⁴

- First quarter report: April 30
- Second quarter report: July 31
- Third quarter report: October 31
- Fourth quarter report and annual report: January 31

RYDACO did not file its 2022 fourth quarter and annual reports with the Commissioner by the deadline of January 31, 2023. The Consumer Credit Commissioner (“Commissioner”) may issue an injunction ordering a credit access business to file one or more complete, accurate, and timely quarterly or annual reports if the Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that the credit access business is violating Chapter 393 of the Texas Finance Code.⁵

The Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that RYDACO is violating Chapter 393 of the Texas Finance Code, and therefore issues this Order, because RYDACO failed to timely file its 2022 fourth quarter and annual reports.

Order

IT IS ORDERED that RYDACO, LLC:

1. comply with, and cease and desist from violating, the reporting requirements set forth in Section 393.627 of the Texas Finance Code and Title 7, Section 83.5001 of the Texas Administrative Code;
2. file its 2022 fourth quarter and annual reports no later than 30 days after the date of this Order, if it has not already done so; and
3. timely file complete and accurate future quarterly and annual reports.

Credit access business quarterly and annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC’s Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): alecs.occ.texas.gov. Instructions are available by clicking the “File Annual Report” button on the OCCC’s home page, occ.texas.gov.

Violation of Order

If you violate this Order, the OCCC may impose an administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 per day.⁶ Multiple violations may also result in the suspension or revocation of your license.⁷

Right to Request Hearing

You have the right to request a hearing regarding this Order.⁸ Your request must be made in writing and sent to the OCCC no later than 30 days after the date of this Order.⁹ You must send your request to Audrey Spalding, Assistant General Counsel, by mail to 2601 N. Lamar Blvd., Austin, TX 78705, or by email to audrey.spalding@occc.texas.gov.

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code.¹⁰ If you fail to request a hearing by this deadline, this Order is considered final and enforceable.¹¹
