**ORDER IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY**

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order Imposing Administrative Penalty against Daniel Baca d/b/a Wild West Pawn (“Wild West Pawn”).<sup>1</sup>

**Statement of Facts and Law**

Wild West Pawn is a pawnshop licensed by the OCCC under Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code. Wild West Pawn operates under master file number 1600056174 at one licensed location, under license number 156181. Wild West Pawn’s compliance officer is Jack Baca, and its designated contact address is 117 E. Houston, Sherman, Texas 75090.

A pawnshop must file annual reports with the OCCC.<sup>2</sup> A pawnshop must comply with all instructions from the OCCC relating to submitting the report, and must file a report for each licensed location.<sup>3</sup> The report is due by July 31 of each year for the prior calendar year’s activity.<sup>4</sup>

On November 6, 2020, the OCCC issued an Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports (the “Order”) against Wild West Pawn for failing to timely file its 2019 annual report. The Order required Wild West Pawn to timely file complete and accurate future reports.

Wild West Pawn did not file its 2022 annual report by the deadline of July 31, 2023.

The Consumer Credit Commissioner (“Commissioner”) may issue an injunction ordering a pawnshop to file one or more complete, accurate, and timely annual reports if the Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that the pawnshop is violating Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code.<sup>5</sup> The Commissioner may impose an administrative penalty on a pawnshop that violates an injunction.<sup>6</sup>

By failing to timely file its 2022 annual report, Wild West Pawn has violated Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code and the OCCC’s Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports.

### **Order**

IT IS ORDERED that Daniel Baca d/b/a Wild West Pawn:

1. pay an administrative penalty in the amount of \$500.00 (calculated as \$500.00 each for Wild West Pawn’s one licensed location) no later than 30 days after the date of this Order; and
2. file its 2022 annual report no later than 30 days after the date of this Order, if it has not already done so.

Pawnshop annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC’s Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): [alecs.occ.texas.gov](https://alecs.occ.texas.gov). Instructions are available by clicking the “File Annual Report” button on the OCCC’s home page, [occ.texas.gov](https://occ.texas.gov).

## Right to Request Hearing

You have the right to request a hearing regarding this Order.<sup>7</sup> To request a hearing, you must send a written hearing request to the OCCC no later than 30 days after the date of this Order.<sup>8</sup> You must send your request to Vivek Vedanarayanan, Assistant General Counsel, by mail to 2601 N. Lamar Blvd., Austin, Texas 78705, or by email to [vivek.vedanarayanan@occc.texas.gov](mailto:vivek.vedanarayanan@occc.texas.gov).

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code.<sup>9</sup> If you fail to request a hearing by the deadline, this Order will be considered final and enforceable.<sup>10</sup>
