**ORDER TO FILE TIMELY AND ACCURATE ANNUAL REPORTS**

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports against Thomas Pesek d/b/a Flag City Pawn (“Flag City Pawn”).<sup>1</sup>

**Statement of Facts and Law**

Flag City Pawn is a pawnshop licensed by the OCCC under Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code. Flag City Pawn operates under master file number 2200071601 at one licensed location, under license number 168368. Flag City Pawn’s compliance officer is Amanda Pesek, and its designated contact address is 210 N. Wells St., Edna, Texas 77957.

A pawnshop must file annual reports with the OCCC.<sup>2</sup> A pawnshop must comply with all instructions from the OCCC relating to submitting the report and must file a report for each licensed location.<sup>3</sup> The report is due by July 31 of each year for the prior calendar year’s activity.<sup>4</sup>

Flag City Pawn did not file its 2023 annual report by the deadline of July 31, 2024.

The Consumer Credit Commissioner (“Commissioner”) may issue an injunction ordering a pawnshop to file one or more complete, accurate, and timely annual reports if the Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that the pawnshop is violating Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code.<sup>5</sup>

The Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that Flag City Pawn is violating Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code, and therefore issues this Order, because Flag City Pawn failed to timely file its 2023 annual report.

## **Order**

IT IS ORDERED that Thomas Pesek d/b/a Flag City Pawn:

1. comply with, and cease and desist from violating, the reporting requirements set forth in 371.201 of the Texas Finance Code and Title 7, Section 85.502 of the Texas Administrative Code;
2. file its 2023 annual report within 30 days of the date of this Order, if it has not already done so; and
3. timely file complete and accurate future annual reports.

Pawnshop annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC’s Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): [alecs.occc.texas.gov](http://alecs.occc.texas.gov). Instructions are available by clicking the “File Annual Report” button on the OCCC’s home page, [occc.texas.gov](http://occc.texas.gov).

## **Violation of Order**

If you violate this Order, the OCCC may impose an administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 for each day.<sup>6</sup> Multiple violations may also result in the suspension or revocation of your license.<sup>7</sup>

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code.<sup>10</sup> If you fail to request a hearing by the deadline, this Order will be considered final and enforceable.<sup>11</sup>

**ORDER TO FILE TIMELY AND ACCURATE ANNUAL REPORTS**

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports against All-Star Pawn LLC (“All-Star Pawn”).<sup>1</sup>

**Statement of Facts and Law**

All-Star Pawn is a pawnshop licensed by the OCCC under Chapter 371 of the Texas Finance Code. All-Star Pawn operates under master file number 16606 at one licensed location, under license number 5340. All-Star Pawn’s compliance officer is Jerry Weakley, and its designated contact address is 2821 Field St., Haltom City, Texas 76117.

A pawnshop must file annual reports with the OCCC.<sup>2</sup> A pawnshop must comply with all instructions from the OCCC relating to submitting the report and must file a report for each licensed location.<sup>3</sup> The report is due by July 31 of each year for the prior calendar year’s activity.<sup>4</sup>

All-Star Pawn did not file its 2023 annual report by the deadline of July 31, 2024.

## **Order**

IT IS ORDERED that All-Star Pawn LLC:

1. comply with, and cease and desist from violating, the reporting requirements set forth in 371.201 of the Texas Finance Code and Title 7, Section 85.502 of the Texas Administrative Code;
2. file its 2023 annual report within 30 days of the date of this Order, if it has not already done so; and
3. timely file complete and accurate future annual reports.
