RE: 2020-21 Texas Financial Education Endowment Grant Recipients

Austin, Texas – Ten organizations have been awarded funding through the Texas Financial Education Endowment. The endowment is funded through assessments on credit access businesses statewide and is administered by the Finance Commission of Texas. It is designed to support and promote statewide financial capability, education, and responsibility.

Ten organizations were awarded an aggregate amount of \$300,000.

K-12 Financial Education & Capability Building Financial Capacity Coalition, Rio Grande Valley - \$27,000 FirstLight Community Foundation, El Paso Area - \$13,000 Girl Scouts of Northeast Texas, Dallas County – \$35,000

Adult Financial Education & Capability Family Eldercare, Austin, TX - \$30,000 Foundation Communities, Austin and Round Rock areas - \$30,000 Women's Resource of Greater Houston, Houston area - \$35,000

Financial Coaching Center for Transforming Lives, Dallas/Fort Worth Area \$35,000 Easter Seals of Greater Houston, Houston area - \$35,000 Family Service Association of San Antonio, San Antonio Area \$30,000 Texas State Affordable Housing, Statewide - \$30,000
