**ORDER IMPOSING ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY**

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner (“OCCC”) issues this Order Imposing Administrative Penalty against AC Autopay LLC (“AC Autopay”).<sup>1</sup>

**Statement of Facts and Law**

AC Autopay is a regulated lender licensed by the OCCC under Chapter 342 of the Texas Finance Code. AC Autopay operates under master file number 15110 at one licensed location, under license number 152590. AC Autopay’s compliance officer is Jeff Hutcheson, and its designated contact address is 1147 Broadway, Suite 100, Denver, Colorado 80203.

A regulated lender must file annual reports with the Consumer Credit Commissioner (“Commissioner”).<sup>2</sup> A regulated lender must comply with all instructions from the OCCC relating to submitting the report.<sup>3</sup> The report is due by May 1 of each year for the prior calendar year’s loan activity.<sup>4</sup> For 2019 annual reports, the OCCC allowed 31 additional days (until June 1, 2020) for regulated lenders to file reports.

On May 25, 2016, the OCCC issued an Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports against AC Autopay for failing to timely file its 2015 annual report. AC Autopay did not request a hearing on the Order, and the Order became final and enforceable. The Order required AC Autopay to timely file complete and accurate future reports.

AC Autopay did not file its 2019 annual report with the Commissioner on or before June 1, 2020.

The Commissioner may issue an injunction ordering a regulated lender to file one or more complete, accurate, and timely annual reports if the Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that the regulated lender is violating Chapter 342 of the Texas Finance Code.<sup>5</sup> The Commissioner may impose an administrative penalty on a regulated lender that violates an injunction.<sup>6</sup>

By failing to timely file its 2019 annual report, AC Autopay has violated Chapter 342 of the Texas Finance Code and the OCCC's Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports.

## **Order**

IT IS ORDERED that AC Autopay LLC:

1. pay an administrative penalty in the amount of **\$1,000.00**, calculated as \$1,000.00 each for AC Autopay's one licensed location, within 30 days of service of this Order; and
2. file its 2019 annual report within 30 days of service of this Order, if it has not already done so.

Regulated lender annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC's Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): [alecs.occ.texas.gov](http://alecs.occ.texas.gov). ## **Right to Request Hearing**

You have the right to request a hearing regarding this Order. To request a hearing, you must send a written hearing request to the OCCC no later than 30 days after service of this Order. You must send your request to Matthew Nance, Deputy General Counsel, by mail to 2601 N. Lamar Blvd., Austin, Texas 78705, or by email to [matthew.nance@occc.texas.gov](mailto:matthew.nance@occc.texas.gov).

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code. If you fail to request a hearing by the deadline, this Order will be considered final and enforceable.
