# CRAFTED PRECIOUS METALS DEALERS







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As defined in Chapter 1956 of the Texas
 Occupations Code, a crafted precious metal
 dealer is a person registered to engage in the
 business of purchasing and selling precious
 metal items, except for: coins, bars,
 commemorative medallions, or items that the
 dealer purchases for 105% or more of scrap
 value.



### Registrations on or before June 30, 2018

If a crafted precious metal dealer obtains or renews a registration for a permanent registered location on or before June 30, 2018, the dealer's registration will be effective for one year after the date of the registration, and will expire on the anniversary of the date of registration. After the expiration of a permanent registered location registration obtained on or before June 30, 2018, a dealer must register for a permanent registered location using the OCCC online registration portal in order to continue doing business as a crafted precious metal dealer.

### Registrations on or after July 1, 2018.

On or after July 1, 2018, all registrations and renewals for crafted precious metal dealers will be performed through the OCCC online registration portal. If a dealer obtains a registration for a permanent registered location or before December 31, 2018, then the registration will expire on December 31, 2019.

Transition from DPS to OCCC RULE § 85.1012



The application must include the following information and any other information required by the OCCC. All questions must be answered.

- (1) Responsible persons. The application must list the person responsible for the day-to-day operation of the applicant's permanent registered location and a responsible person for each temporary location.
- (2) Assumed names. For any applicant that does business under an "assumed name" as that term is defined in Texas Business and Commerce Code, § 71.002, the applicant must provide all assumed names used.
- (3) Permanent registered location required. A dealer must have at least one, and may have more than one, permanent registered location. If none of a dealer's locations satisfies the permanent registered location definition contained in § 85.1001 of this title (relating to Definitions), the dealer must designate one location to be the permanent registered location.
- (4) Temporary locations. For each temporary location, the dealer must provide the approximate dates of operation at each temporary location.




- As CPMD transitions from DPS to OCCC, new applicants and renewals will be required to submit a Crafted Precious Metal Dealer application




Complete the information requested.

Ownership Type - Sole proprietors will enter their social security number. Entities (LLC, Corporation, Partnerships, etc) will enter a Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN)






 Complete all mandatory fields and hit next.






- If you are using a DBA, type in the DBA and attach the assumed name certificate from the county clerk (sole propiertor or partnerships) Or Secretary of state (LLC's, Corps & other entities not listed from the county clerk) by clicking select.
- When all mandatory fields are complete, hit next.

Remember, if you fill in the DBA operating field, you will be required to submit an assumed certificate name filed with the Secretary of State or County Clerk if Sole Proprietor or Partnership.





- The fee for new applicants and renewals is \$50.00.
- The application is automatically approved.
- Choose the payment type, read the statement and if you agree select the checkbox and hit Pay Now.



TEMPORARY LOCATION








 Once you have completed your permanent location application and printed your certificate, return to Dashboard and from here click on Submit Application.




Click on Crafted Precious Metals Dealer



 Once you have completed the application process, select Manage My Business from your Dashboard.




 Select Print Registration
