

Data contained within the below summary represents aggregated, statewide third-quarter data reported by credit access businesses (CABs) as of 12/02/2014. The OCCC will request verification from the licensee of any data that is found to be questionable or unreasonable.

Section 393.627 of the Texas Finance Code requires CABs to file quarterly reports with the OCCC identifying loan activity associated with

- single and installment deferred presentment (payday) loans, and
- single and installment auto title loans.

Data Limitations

Data provided by reporting CABs reflects location-specific activity for the identified quarter. Reported data has been aggregated and presented below to reflect statewide activity within this industry.

The data presented in the following summary represents CAB submissions via electronic and manual reporting, including any corrected data, of third-quarter activity as of December 2, 2014. Amended or corrected reports will be included in later publications as appropriate.
