# ORDER TO FILE TIMELY AND ACCURATE ANNUAL REPORTS

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner ("OCCC") issues this Order to File Timely and Accurate Annual Reports against Texas Tax Solution LLC ("Texas Tax Solution").<sup>1</sup>

### Statement of Facts and Law

Texas Tax Solution is a property tax lender licensed by the OCCC under Chapter 351 of the Texas Finance Code. Texas Tax Solution operates under master file number 14579 at one licensed location, under license number 54884. Texas Tax Solution's compliance officer is Stephen Vaughan, and its designated contact address is 4000 W. Vickery Blvd., Fort Worth, Texas 76107.

A property tax lender must file annual reports with the Consumer Credit Commissioner ("Commissioner").<sup>2</sup> A property tax lender must comply with all instructions from the OCCC relating to submitting the report.<sup>3</sup> The report is due by March 31 of each year for the prior calendar year's loan activity.<sup>4</sup>

Texas Tax Solution did not file its 2021 annual report by March 31, 2022, for one licensed location, under license number 54884.

The Commissioner may issue an injunction ordering a property tax lender to file one or more complete, accurate, and timely annual reports if the Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that the property tax lender is violating Chapter 351 of the Texas Finance Code.<sup>5</sup>

The Commissioner has reasonable cause to believe that Texas Tax Solution is violating Chapter 351 of the Texas Finance Code, and therefore issues this Order, because Texas Tax Solution failed to timely file its 2021 annual report.

#### Order

IT IS ORDERED that Texas Tax Solution LLC:

- 1. comply with, and cease and desist from violating, the reporting requirements set forth in Section 351.164 of the Texas Finance Code and Title 7, Section 89.404 of the Texas Administrative Code;
- 2. file its 2021 annual report within 30 days of the date of this Order, if it has not already done so; and
- 3. timely file complete and accurate future annual reports.

Property tax lender annual reports must be submitted through the OCCC's Application Licensing Examination and Compliance System (ALECS): alecs.occc.texas.gov. Instructions are available by clicking the "File Annual Report" button on the OCCC's home page, occc.texas.gov.

# Violation of Order

If you violate this Order, the OCCC may impose an administrative penalty of up to \$1,000 for each day.<sup>6</sup> Multiple violations may also result in the suspension or revocation of your license.<sup>7</sup>

# **Right to Request Hearing**

You have the right to request a hearing regarding this Order. To request a hearing, you must send a written hearing request to the OCCC no later than 30 days after the date of this Order. You must send your request to Matthew Nance, Deputy General Counsel, by mail to 2601 N. Lamar Blvd., Austin, Texas 78705, or by email to matthew.nance@occc.texas.gov.

If you request a hearing, a hearing on this matter will be set and conducted in accordance with Chapter 2001 of the Texas Government Code.<sup>10</sup> If you fail to request a hearing by the deadline, this Order will be considered final and enforceable.<sup>11</sup>
